Students in **GRADES 5 TO 12** are invited to apply for scholarships for summer classes in the arts offered at recognized schools such as Summer Band Camps, University of Regina, University of Saskatchewan, Emma Lake, Muenster, the International Music Camp at the Peace Gardens, Drewitz School of Dance, Saskatchewan Writers' Guild, Saskatchewan Choral Federation, Sage Hill Writing Experiences Inc., Festival of Words Teen Writing Workshop, etc.

Classes in such art forms as visual arts, dance, band, choir, creative writing, guitar, highland piping and drumming, drama, and others are eligible for consideration. - limit application to Grade 5 to 12 in the Estevan area
- the Eli Mandel scholarship is for creative writing and does not necessarily have to be given each year. Eli Mandel was an Estevan writer/poet and the scholarship was named in his honor.
- evidence of community involvement and sharing of talents
- attempt to provide scholarships to as many different categories, if there are worthy candidates
- select one or two alternates
- attempt to distribute to different schools, grades and sexes
- scholarships may be given to previous recipients
- apparent financial need is not a criteria
- scholarships may be given to more than one applicant in a family
- the application should be completed by the student, not the parent or instructor
- the application should be fully completed
- no scholarship is given to someone for a private instructor
